Becoming Royal Turks and Caicos Golf Club reflects both the vision for the future and our long history and heritage associated with the Turks and Caicos Islands we call home, where the community has welcomed us and supported our growth and ideas.

Throughout the clubs' 30-year history there has been substantial and continued improvements to both the course and the clubhouse to ensure it climbed the ranks within the Caribbean. Rooted deep in our foundation is our obsession to move forward and offer the absolute best in terms of product and experience from the fleet of EZGO electric golf-carts to the newest Titleist rental clubs. Director of Golf Dave Douglas and Golf Professional Sean Wilson are constantly setting our bar a little bit higher daily to ensure we deliver a one-of-a-kind memory, with our goal being to take the club from a good one to a great one.



The Club has always invested heavily in upgrading facilities. The most recent being a switch to Platinum Paspalum grass, the new standard of the golf industry. Superintendent Tim Mack, and his talented crew over 12 months transformed the course. Using their "magical bags of fertilizer" they made many changes, leading to fairways and greens that are either deceptively flat as a pancake or full of nasty little undulations. Known for its dark green grass the refurbishment not only provides an improved player experience but reduces water consumption by over 30%. Golf Course GREEN is GOOD and so is the conservation direction at the Club.

Now this 72-par golf course is recognized as one of the finest in the Caribbean. From the black tees the championship layout of 6719 yards can certainly be challenging, though with four sets of tees both accomplished and less experienced golfers will relish this mature and satisfying course and enjoy their speedy (4 hours or less) round.

The holes play over a variety of natural vistas. The mix of native and palm lined fairways, scenic inland water hazards combined with straight and bending design shapes create ample opportunities for risks or rewards! The eleven lakes and hundreds of new trees and flowers have enhanced the club's biodiversity resulting in a huge increase in wildlife. While playing golfers might spot the indigenous Brown Pelican (our golf standard bearer) or Caicos Flamingo during their round. First time and returning golfers will especially love the Instagrammable moment provided by the 17th island green reminiscent of Sawgrass.

Cooled by local trade winds, every changing windy day brings new dimensions into a game. What better way to spend three to four hours than by pitting your golfing prowess against eighteen holes, bathed in sunshine beneath the cloudless sky.

Looking ahead to 2022 we can't help but be extremely optimistic as the course continues to mature and has never been in better condition.

With the continued support of David Feherty as our Golf Club Ambassador, the many relaxed resort golfers and fun-loving members, we are certain this strikes a great tone for all to join in as we aim for the #1 position in The Caribbean.
